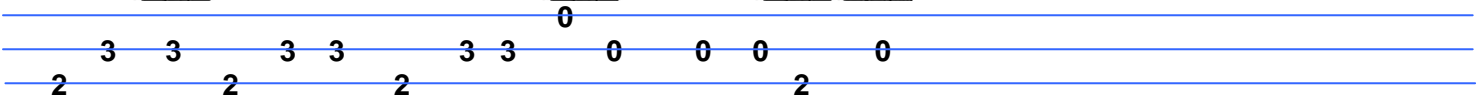
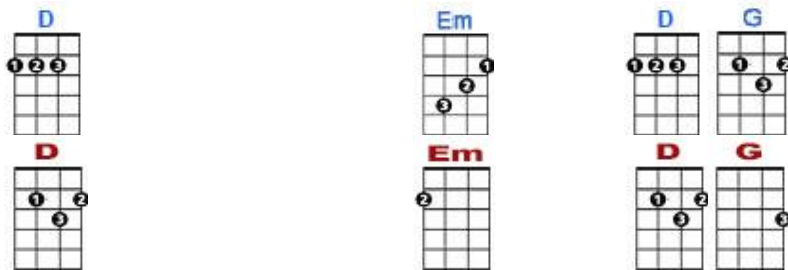
Sometimes you picture me, I'm walk - ing too far a-head. You're calling to me I can't hear what you've said.

BRIDGE:

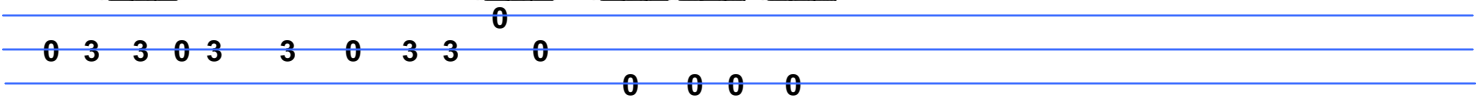
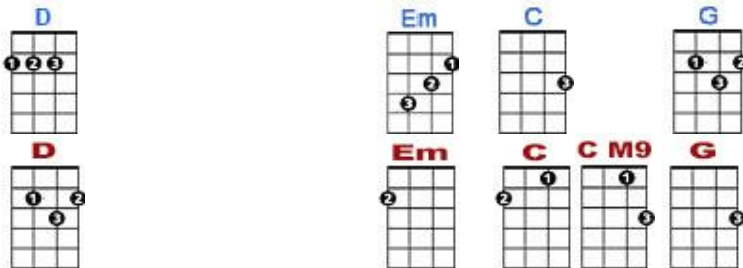


Then you say go slow, I fall behind. The second hand unwinds.
